Smoking statistics - Action on Smoking and Health Smoking prevalence is highest among young adults: 23% of those aged 16-24 and 24% among the 25-34 age group. Smoking continues to be lowest among people aged 60 and over. Although they are more likely than younger people to have ever been smokers, they are more likely to have stopped smoking Daily cigarette smoking, age-standardised Prevalence estimates for daily smoking of cigarettes are age-standardized between surveys, but often means current smoking of cigarettes at least once a day
